

## **Rules**

### *Juried Art Competition*

1. The participant must be accepted and must be in attendance at the event to enter the competition. An agent may assist, but not represent the participant at the event.
  2. To be eligible to compete in the *Juried Art Competition*, an application form, entry fee of \$25 and all other information must be received no later than 4:00PM, Friday, August 27, 2010. The work can be framed or unframed. All times are CDST.
  3. Competition entries must be original artwork by registered participant. No collaborative work may be entered. Items must not have been sold prior to judging; must not have been commissioned and must be the sole property of the registered participant.
  4. Oklahoma Champion Steak Cook-off is not responsible in case of fire, theft or accidents.
  5. Two (2) entries from each participant will be accepted from any of the following categories: Ceramics, oil paint, photography and water color or acrylic paint. Participants electing to display framed or unframed works must supply their own stands.
  6. Awards will be made based upon the participant, not individual categories. All decisions made by the judges shall be final.
  7. First place award is \$300; Second place is \$200, and Third place is \$100.
  8. Participants may bring work on Thursday, August 26<sup>th</sup> from 2:00PM until 4:00PM AND Friday, August 27<sup>th</sup> from 9:00AM until 4:00PM. The exhibit will be open to the public Saturday, August 28<sup>th</sup> promptly at 10:00AM. If you have registered but not paid the \$25 entry fee by 10:00AM on Friday, August 27<sup>th</sup> the space may be given to a person on the approved waiting list.
- In case of emergency, call Trinity Parish at 918-582-4128. This same number may be used to call and make arrangements, if need be, for your registration. After Friday, August 27<sup>th</sup> at 4:00PM no items will be accepted for display.
9. Oklahoma Champion Steak Cook-off reserves the right(s) to use copies of your slides or photos (if any are sent or received) and information for advertising and promotional materials. All exhibit and promotional items MUST be picked up by 9:00PM the evening of the event.
  10. A person may elect to mark an item or item(s) sold at anytime. However, the work can be given to the buyer-elect only between 6:00PM and 9:00PM the day of the event.
